Ethiopian to Launch Cargo Flights to from Zaragoza Bogota via Miami

Addis Ababa, August 31, 2018

Ethiopian Airlines, the largest Aviation Group in Africa and SKYTRAX certified Four Star Global Airline, is pleased to announce that it is set to commence twice weekly freighter service to Bogota, Colombia as of August 29, 2018. The cargo service will depart from Zaragoza (Spain) and will fly to Bogota with a stopover in Miami, using the B777-Freighter.

Regarding the upcoming cargo flight, Mr. Tewolde GebreMariam, Group CEO of Ethiopian Airlines, said: *"We are very pleased to see Zaragoza, Miami and Bogota joining our fast expanding freighter network in the Americas.
