CALL FOR MANUSCRIPTS

BIOTECH & ALLIED SCI. & ENGG. CONFERENCE » PROCEEDING » JOURNAL

The Department of Biological and Chemical Engineering (Mekelle Institute of Tech) and the Department of Biotechnology (College of Dryland Agri. and Nat. Res.) are making preparations to jointly carry out the first conference on biotechnology and allied sciences and engineering called Mekelle University Annual Conference on Biotechnology and Allied Sciences and Engineering (**BASE: MU Annual Conference**). Its proceeding will be published as Mekelle University Annual Conference Abstracts (**BASE: MU Annual Conference Abstracts**). Also, high quality manuscripts will be published in Mekelle University Journal of Biotechnology and Allied Sciences and Engineering (**BASE: MU Journal**).

All submitted manuscripts will pass through rigorous evaluation and review process including blind peer review before accepted for **Conference Presentation** (and subsequent publication in **Conference Abstracts** in the Proceeding) and for publication in the **BASE: MU Journal**.

Interested scholars and researchers are invited to submit: *Journal Articles* (4,500 to 7,000 words), *Poster Presentations* (1,000 to 1,500 words), *Short Communications* (500 to 750 words), *Book Reviews* (300 to 500 words), and *Policy Briefs* (1,000 to 1,500 words). All submissions are made in **MS docx**. Manuscripts that have been submitted, presented, or published before or being considered for conference presentation or journal publication elsewhere cannot be submitted.

The Conference will create platforms for presenting and sharing all types of manuscripts. Abstracts of all presented materials will be published in the **BASE: MU Annual Conference Abstracts**. Moreover, eight to 12 manuscripts will be published in the **BASE: MU Journal** as journal articles. All materials are required to be prepared (written) following the academic writing guidelines of the latest edition of the American Psychology Association.
